Schools across South Africa have found themselves in a predicament. Crime has increased in our youth and this has a negative impact on the day to day management of schools. Learners are exposed to different challenges in school as well as outside of schools.

If anyone is in trouble, the police are available at any time and they have an open door policy. Special learner programs, regular patrols and safety ambassadors are some of the strategies that are being provided for the safety of learners.

According to the officers the consequences are severe. There are two cases that can be opened against you which are, assault common and assault GBN.

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Easy Winter Dinner That Will Keep You Warm

Chicken and Rice Soup

Ingredients:

- 2 chicken breasts
- 2 tablespoons (30 ml) olive oil
- 1 onion, diced
- 1 teaspoon garlic, minced
- 3 carrot, peeled and chopped
- 1 cup long grain rice
- 2 cups chicken stock
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 tablespoon parsley, chopped
- Salt and pepper to taste



Method:

- Season chicken breasts on both sides with salt and pepper.
- In a large pot, heat oil and cook the chicken for 3-4 minutes on each side to brown. Transfer cooked chicken to a plate.
- Add onion, garlic and carrots and sauté for a few minutes
- Add the rice, stir and cook for a minute to toast the grains. Add the chicken, chicken stock, and bay leaf.
- Bring the to a boil, cover the pot and reduce to a simmer over mediumlow heat.
- Simmer the soup until the rice is tender and the chicken is cooked
- Turn off the heat and remove the bay leaf and chicken from the pot.
- Once the chicken is cool enough to handle, shred into smaller pieces then add back to the soup.
- The rice may absorb water as it sits, add more chicken stock if needed.
 Taste the soup and season with more salt and pepper as desired.
- Serve each bowl topped with chopped parsley.

Steamed Bread

Ingredients:

- 1 kg of flour
- 1 teaspoon of salt
- 2 tablespoons of sugar
- 1 teaspoon of dry yeast
- 1/2 a litre of warm water

Method:

- Mix the dry ingredients first and make a little "hole" for the water.
- Pour in the water, mixing carefully until your dough is a smooth, wet batter.
- It should be sticky and not too wet though!
- Cover and let it rise for ±1 hour in a warm environment.
- When it has risen, mix it down again and cover for another ±30 minutes.
- In the meantime, butter an enamel or metal bowl.
- Make sure you have a large pot that can fit the bowl with room enough for you to handle it.
- Once the dough has risen again, put it into the buttered bowl.
- Bring half a litre of water to the boil in the large pot and put the uncooked bread into it. (The water should not reach more than half-way up the bowl).
- Put the lid on and let it steam at medium heat for ± 2 and a half hours.
- If during that time you need to refill the water, remember to do so.
- Before you take the bowl out, make sure that the bread is cooked by using a knife to test the level of stickiness.
- It should not be wet-sticky to the touch.
- When the bread is done, take it out and let it cool a little before serving.







