- Afrikaans First Additional Language – 25

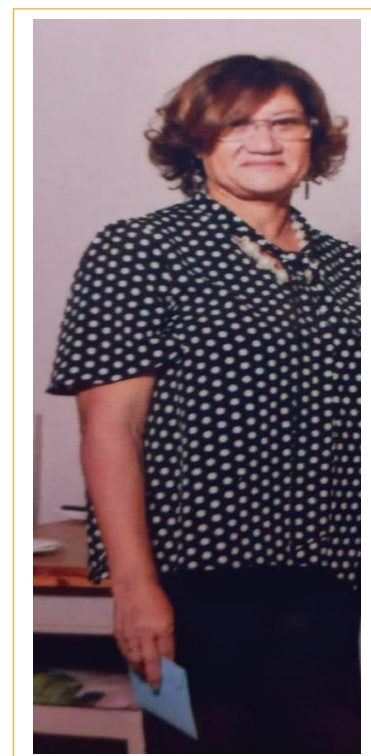
Sarepta is awarded a certificate for the following category: 10% and more improvement in the 2021 NSC pass rate (Minimum 60% pass rate)
